## LOT 205 - 2005 **No. 1 RED**

Aromas of the No. 1 Red are above all, rich and ripe. With lush, inviting plum, black cherry and fig fruit, bolstered by toasty, cedary oak and suggestions of black tea and mocha spice. The palate impression is equally ripe and generous, offering roasted black fruit character with sweet tobacco and cocoa notes. It is a great match for barbeque, hamburgers, pizza, sausages, and semisoft cheeses.
